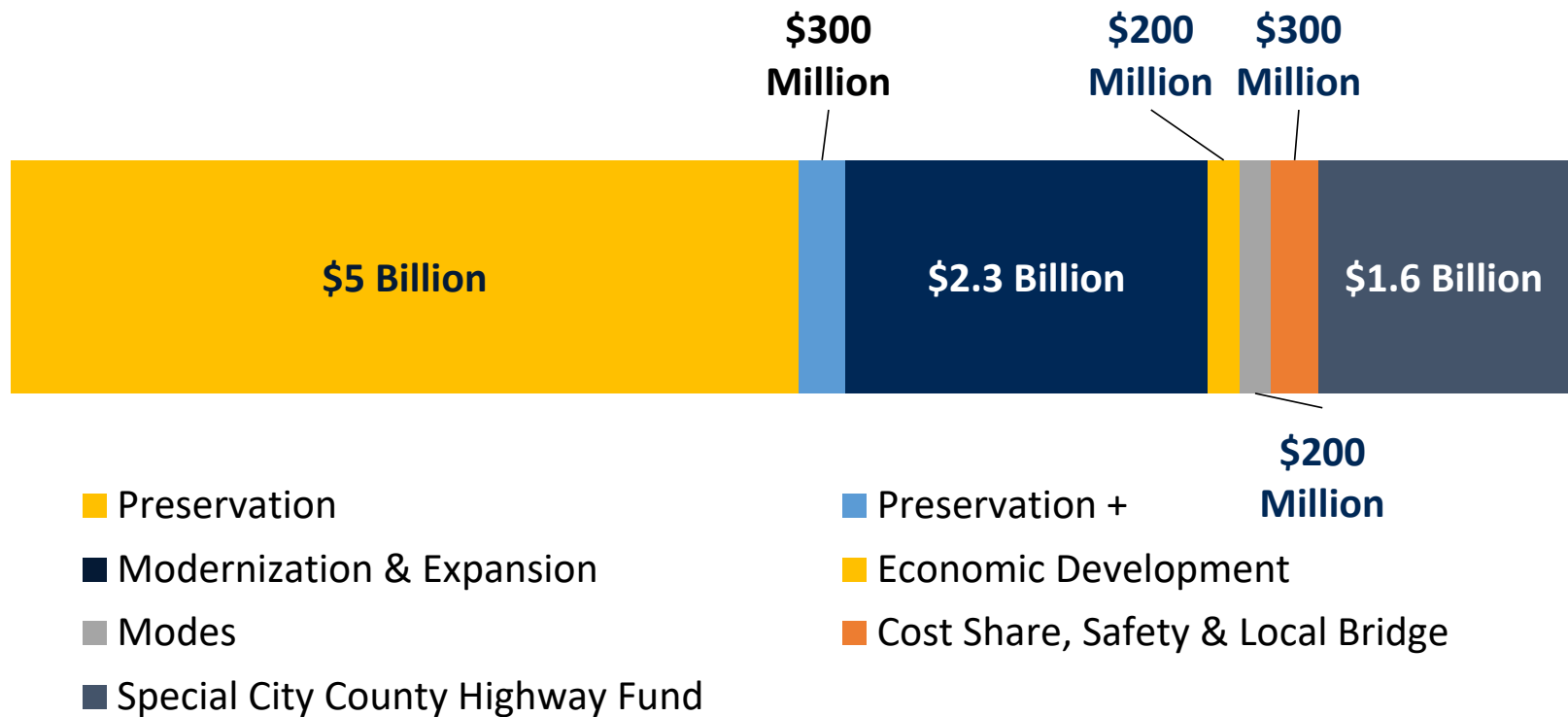

3 major categories of highway projects



Preservation:

Maintaining existing infrastructure (overlays, bridge repairs)



Modernization:

Straightening curves, flattening hills, adding shoulders, widening bridges



Expansion:

Adding lanes or passing lanes, interchanges

Let at least 40% of each district minimum by the end of Fiscal Year 2025



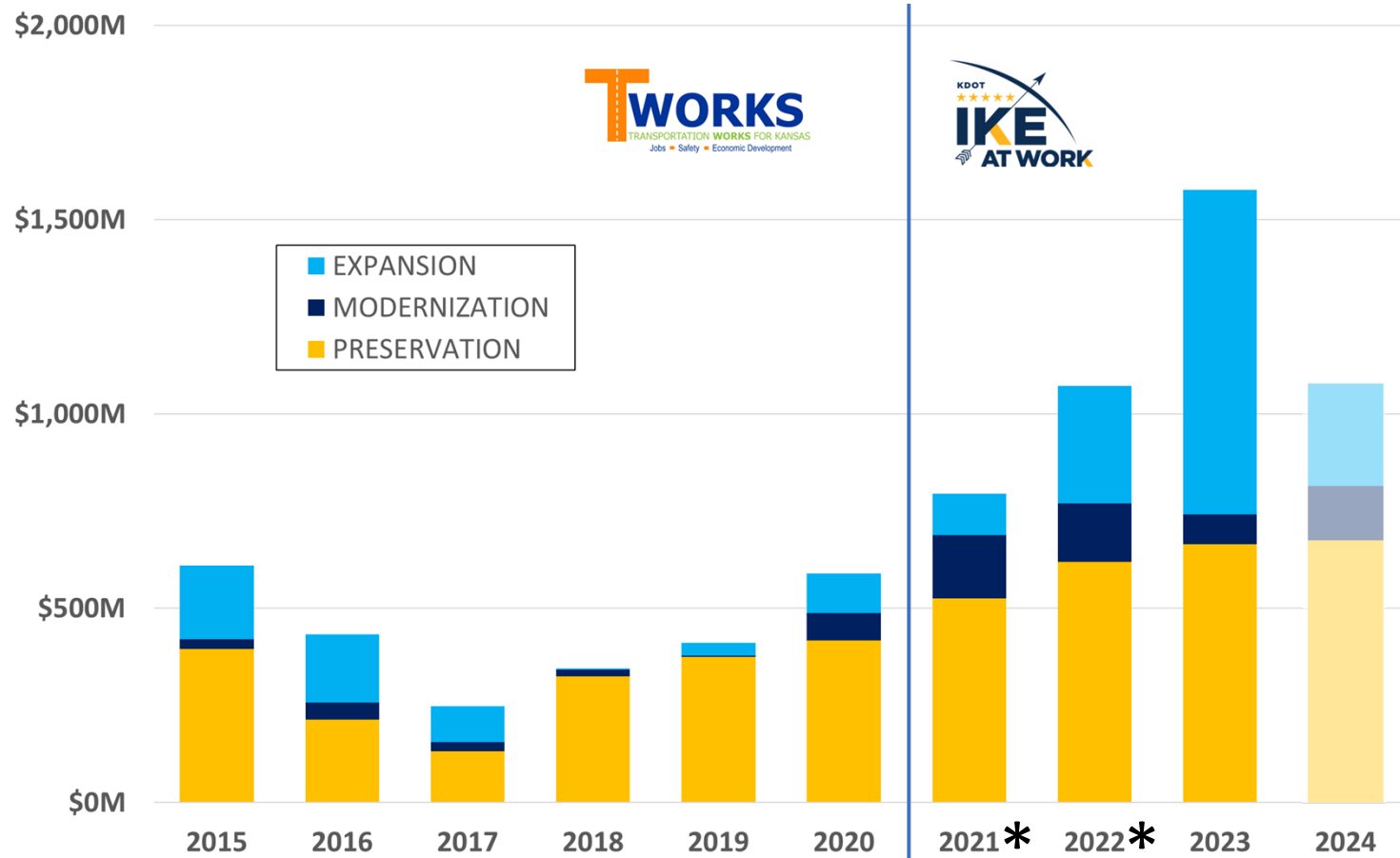

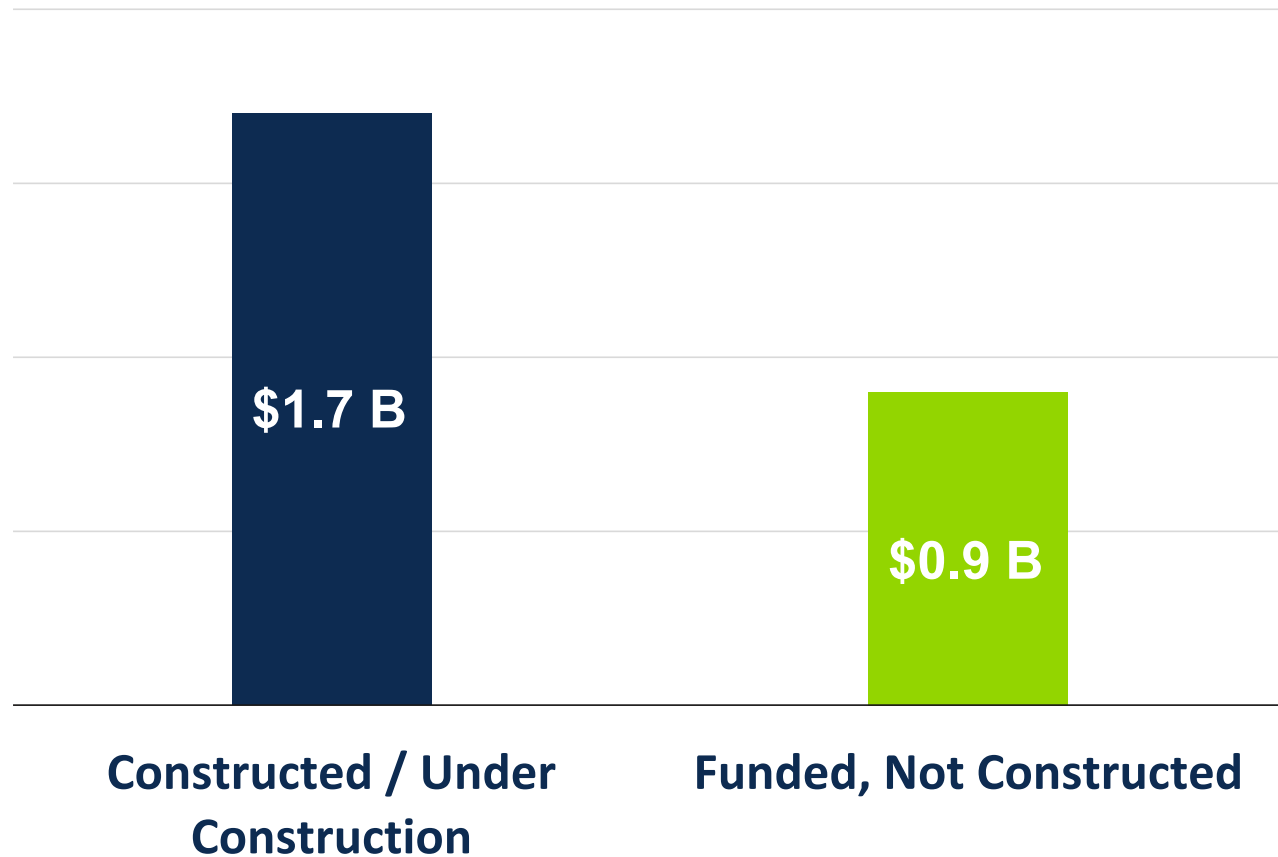

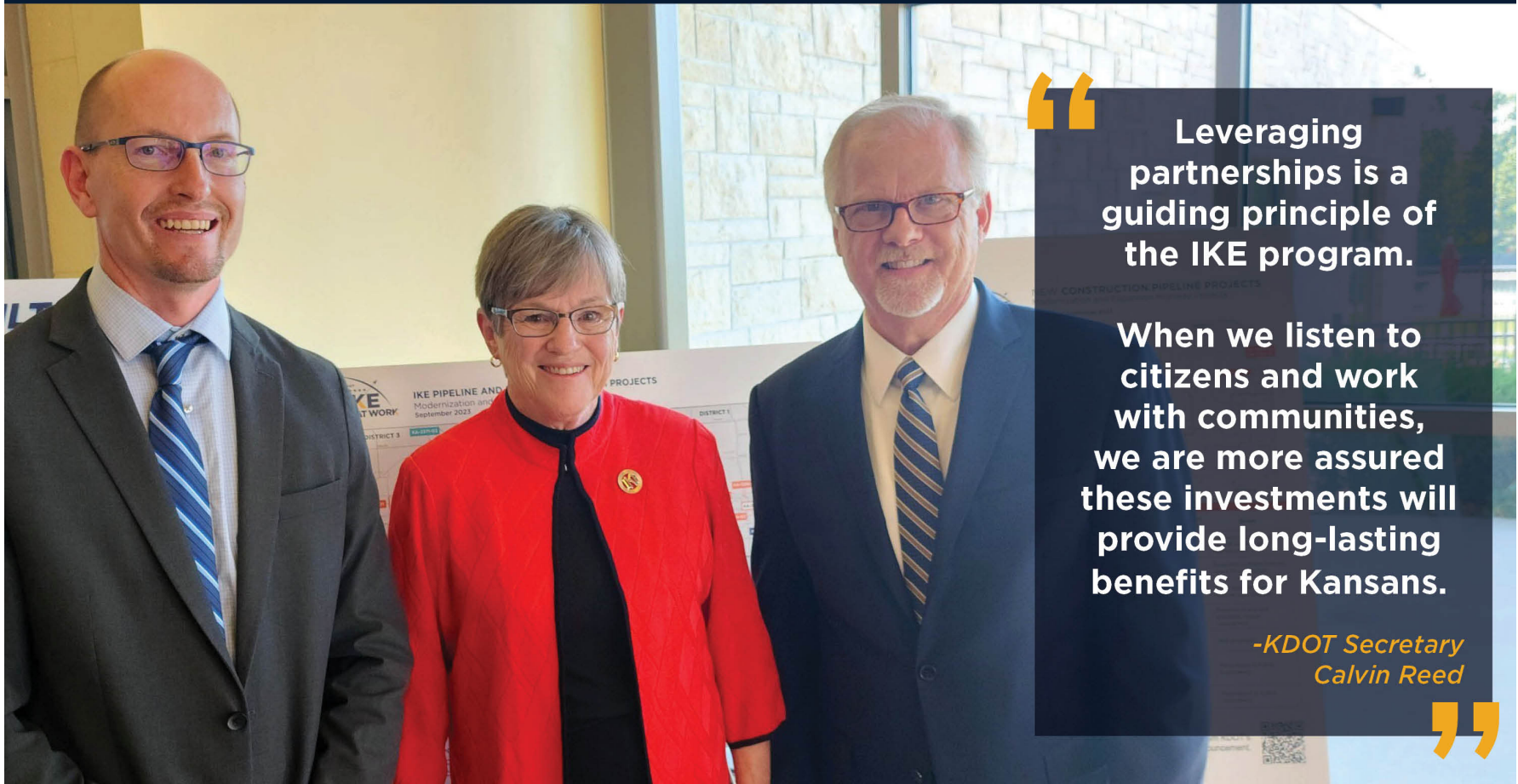

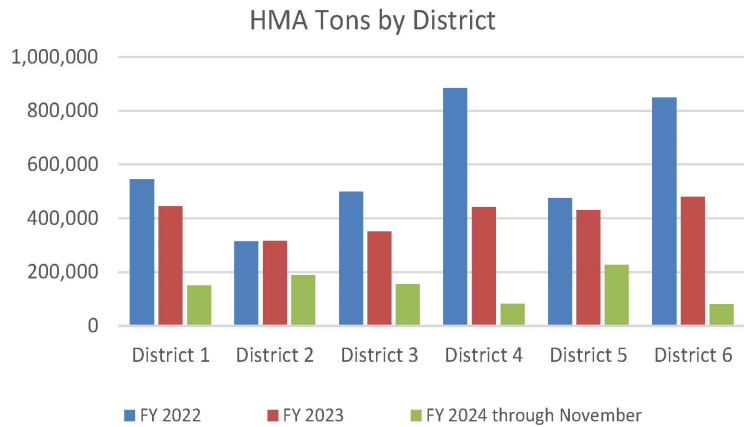

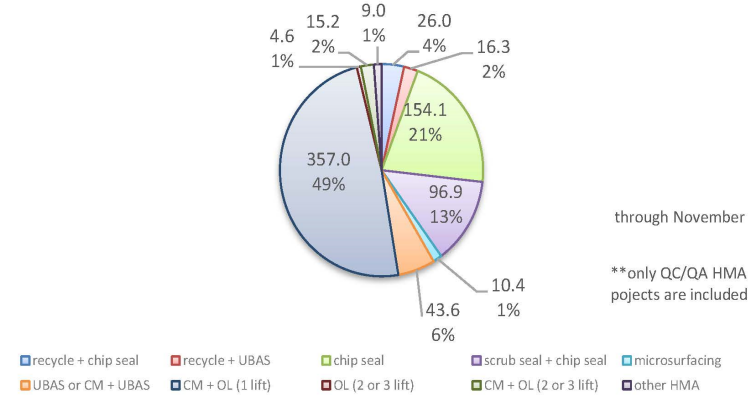
